TRIP DETAILS

DAY-BY-DAY ADVENTURE

Day 1 - Welcome to Zermatt

Arrival, meet your guide, tour briefing.

Day 2 – Let the games begin

Ride up to Klein Matterhorn. First summit: Breithorn (4164 m). Traverse the Verra Glacier and grab the second: Pollux (4091 m). Overnight at the Guide d'Ayas Hut.

Distance: 8.6 km | Time: 6-7 h | Ascent/Descent: +665 m / -1110 m

Day 3 – Snow and silence

Ascend Castor (4226 m) via the southwest flank. Descend across the Felik Glacier to Quintino Sella Hut.

Distance: 5.5 km | Time: 5 h | Ascent/Descent: +795 m / -635 m

Day 4 - Triple crown day

First Il Naso (4272 m), then Balmenhorn (4167 m) via the Lys Glacier, and finish with Vincent Pyramid (4215 m). Hut life at Rifugio Mantova.

Distance: 10.5 km | Time: 7-8 h | Ascent/Descent: +1005 m / -1140 m

Day 5 - Sky-high dreams

Corno Nero (4321 m), Ludwigshöhe (4341 m), Parrotspitze (4436 m), and the grand finale: Signalkuppe (4554 m), home to the highest hut in the Alps—Capanna Margherita.

Distance: 5.5 km | Time: 6 h | Ascent/Descent: +1145 m / -85 m

Day 6 – One last summit

Zumsteinspitze (4563 m) waves you goodbye. Long descent via the Grenz Glacier to Monte Rosa Hut, then Rotenboden station back to Zermatt.

Distance: 15.1 km | Time: 8–9 h | Ascent/Descent: +535 m / -2160 m
